GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (Classes 2011 – 2014)

1. A minimum of 24 credits required for graduation must be in the following areas:

Table with 2 columns: Subject and Credits. Includes Theology (2), English (4), Mathematics (3), Science (3), Social Studies* (3), Consumer Education (0.50), Electives (3), Foreign Language (2), Fine Arts (1.5), PE/Health (1.0), and Computer Science (1).

*Includes U.S. History and American Government.
**Exceptions require administrative approval

- 2. Seniors carry six subjects during senior year.
3. Seniors must have 24 credits to graduate.
4. Seniors must pass a test on the Illinois Constitution, the U.S. Constitution, and display of the flag.

Report Cards are issued quarterly. Grades are given in each subject as follows:

I Incomplete: work must be completed. This is only issued for extenuating circumstances, such as extended illness. Work must be made up within a two (2) week period.

FRESHMEN

SOPHOMORES

Students have earned 6 credits, including successfully passing 1 credit of English, 1 credit of Math, 1 credit of Science and 1 credit of Social Studies

Table with 2 columns: Subject and Credits. Includes Theology II (1.00), World History (1.00), English 2 (1.00), Geometry or Algebra (1.00), Biology (1.00), Language or Communication (1.00), Music or Art (1.00), Physical Education (0.50), and TOTAL CREDITS (7.50).

JUNIORS

Students must have earned 12 credits, including successfully passing 2 credits of English, 2 credits of Math, 2 credits of Science and 2 credits of Social Studies

Table with 2 columns: Subject and Credits. Includes Theology III (0.50), English 3 (1.00), US History (1.00), Mathematics (1.00), Science (1.00), Physical Education (0.50), Electives (1.00), and TOTAL CREDITS (6.00).

SENIORS

Students must have earned 18 credits, including successfully passing 3 credits of English, 3 credits of Math, 2 credits of Science and 3 credits of Social Studies
